## Autumn Term 2 Curriculum

Maths-We will be learning to name 2D and 3D shapes. Perhaps you can spot shapes with your child as you go for a walk.


We will also be doing lots of addition. We will use cubes and numberlines. If you would like to practise at home then you could practise with real life objects such as sweets or toy cars. The Topmarks website has some good addition and subtraction games on: Mental Maths Train - A Four Operations Game (topmarks.co. Uk) Click on + - and then 'up to 10' to start with.

English-We will be ensuring our letters are formed correctly, using full stops and capital letters and exploring familiar stories. In Read, Write, Inc we are learning our set 2 or set 3 sounds with 'special friends'. E.g play, bean, light.

Topic-We will discuss Bonfire Night and Guy Fawkes. We will also be looking at the different colour poppies in our Remembrance Day discussions. In History we are learning about toys from the past and the children have already enjoyed playing with old toys. In design technology we are making moving part Christmas cards. In computing we are logging on and using an art package.

PE-In PE we are exploring 'Starry Skies' in dance and Invasion Games in outdoor PE

RE-We are learning about books and stories in Christianity.
