Delapre Primary School NEWSLETTER - Autumn Term

English

To support English this term we will be reading 'How to wash a woolly mammoth', a great way to learn how to write instructions. The story of 'Stone-age Boy' who learns what life was like during this interesting period in history. Finally in the second half of the term we will be reading 'Charlie and The Chocolate factory', a magical story loved by generations.

Maths

Our first Year 3 topics this term will be place value, addition and subtraction. For place value we will be understanding, reading and writing numbers up to 1000. We will then also learn the column method for addition and subtraction. This will include exchanging in both addition and subtraction, with 2 and 3 digits.

Science

We are investigating rocks and soils. This links to our stone-age topic. We experiment with the characteristics of rocks and soils including making our own fossil.

PF

PE days are Mondays (unless your class is swimming) and Wednesdays. Outdoor PE day, they will need suitable trousers/shorts and outdoor trainers. Plimsoles are needed for indoor PE. Please remember, no earrings are to be worn on PE days. A cap is advisable for warmer days.

Computing

We have fantastic new ICT equipment, and this term is about creating digital content. We will learn how to plan and create stop motion video and explore different types of creative media including PowerPoint and Canva.

Art/DT

In art this term, children will be exploring stone age art including what materials these eras would use for their art. Children will explore the illustrations of Quentin Blake who illustrated many of Roald Dahls books.

Humanities

Over this term we will be learning all about the stone age. Children investigate what it was like to live in the stone age. Children will compare the stone age, bronze, and iron age top each other and how it compares with life in the modern day.

PPA

On Thursday mornings, Year 3 teachers are out of the classroom planning. The children will have Miss Johnson (PSHE), Mr. Kelly (French/Music) and Miss Cripps (RE). French will be learning the alphabet and exploring French culture. In RE humanism and Christianity including the Christmas story.

Welcome back Year 3!

Welcome to Year 3! We are looking forward to a fun-filled term of learning. Just a reminder of the expectations of Year 3.

PE Days are **Monday** (unless swimming) and **Wednesday**. Your child will no longer come to school in PE kit but must change in school. You may leave your kit at school (named in a PE bag). Please ensure your children have the appropriate kit on these days, no jewellery and that long hair is tied up. Children will need kits for both indoor and outdoor PE lessons.

Homework

Homework is set on **Friday** and must be handed in by the following **Wednesday**. Any problems please see your child's class teacher or write us a note. If you want to hand in homework early, you're welcome to.

Clubs

Please keep an eye out for any clubs happening at lunch and before/after school. These are usually first come first served e be prompt returning slips.

Reading

Each night, please listen to your child read for about 10–15 minutes and sign their reading diary. If your child is a 'free reader', they will be expected to write their own comment. If your child does not read for two consecutive nights, they will be given the opportunity to read for 5 minutes at playtime. A reading will be issued in the first week. Levels are moved based on verbal reading and comprehension skills.

Book bags

Your child is expected to bring their book bags to school and take them home every day. Please check these each night carefully for any letters. At school, these will be kept in their own drawers. Please keep your child's reading book, diary, and homework book in this book bag.

Spellings and Times Tables

In Year 3, your child will be given a set of spellings and relevant times tables to learn each week for a test. Times-tables will set by your child's Maths teacher and spellings will be tested and given out on a Monday.
