### ABOUT YEAR 5

Here are some important classroom procedures to remember for the school year:

- Spellings will now be in the back of your child's Reading Diaries so you can see your child's progress each week.
- Your child will be expected to read on a regular basis and bring their reading diary and book to school every day.
- English and Maths homework will be sent home on Friday to be handed in the following Thursday. There is a homework club on Monday/Tuesday lunchtime in 5C for any children in Year 5 who need support or time to complete their homework in school.
- Spellings and times tables will be set on a weekly basis. The school has invested in memberships of Spelling Shed and Times Table Rockstars which we would recommend your child uses on a weekly basis. All log in details are in their Reading Diaries.

### REMINDERS

- Please send a named water bottle in with your child. Additionally, on the cooler days please remember to send hats and gloves in.
- Please ensure that your child's snack money is paid promptly each term. This costs £5 each term and can be paid through ParentPay or in a named envelope.
- If your child attends an after-school club, they must be picked up by an adult, even if they have returned their walking slip. This will last until the Spring 2 term.
